### Music Notes:

We're pleased to feature Cedar Lane member David Meredith as this morning's vocalist. *These Hands* was composed by Canadian singer/songwriter Dave Gunning, considered one of Canada's finest "roots"/traditional song stylists. The song's lyrics point to every person's ability to make a difference in this world. In fact, *These Hands* is also the title of Gunning's popular children's book portraying the message in beautiful pictures and including lyrics and sheet music for the song. Bob Dylan composed *The Times They Are a-Changin'* in 1964 in a style of the prevalent folk music revolution (*Come gather round people...*) while highlighting the civil rights issues of the era. Some historians remarked that the song was outdated almost at the time it was written. But its lyrics strike a familiar tone in today's political and social climates.
